<u>Call to Order by the Chairman</u>: The Chairman called the regular meeting of the Macon-Bibb County Board of Tax Assessors to order at 2:00 p.m.

CHIEF APPRAISER'S REPORT

- 1. 2025 Appeal Update Ms. Crutchfield gave an update on the 2025 Appeals. There has been a total of 861 appeals as of today. There are currently 266 active appeals, (188) thirty-day notices, (200) no change, (66) resolved appeals and (61) withdrawn.
- 2. Ms. Crutchfield gave an update on the 2025 digest. The 2025 tax digest was turned over to the Tax Commissioner's Office on Wednesday, July 16, 2025.
- A. Residential Division—Ms. Bishop gave an updated report on the Residential Division. The staff have been working on appeals, new construction, permits, and neighborhood reviews. There are (113) thirty-day notices and (53) certified to BOE for today's meeting. There are currently (8) active appeals remaining with three of those being appeals to Arbitration that are waiting on appraisals. There have been (44) withdrawals to date and currently there are 6 days of hearings scheduled for August.
- B. Commercial Division Mr. Claborn gave an updated report on the Commercial Division. The Commercial Division has received 248 Commercial appeals for 2025. There are 141 active appeals, (26) thirty-day notices, (8) certified to BOE, (46) active for Hearing Officer, (14) certified to a Hearing Officer, (9) resolved and (5) withdrawn for today's meeting. The Commercial Division is currently working on completing field work for any appeals and for the 1/3 parcel reviews throughout the county. This includes commercial, industrial and exempt properties. There are currently 45 permits for 2025 for review.
- C. Personal Property Ms. Crutchfield gave an updated report for the Personal Property Division. They have received (103) personal property appeals to date and (2) car appeals. There are (4) errors and adjustments and (7) withdrawals listed on the Consent Agenda for today's meeting.
